## Pooled Fund Criteria: for targeted, aligned, collective action to reach our goals.

## We fund strategies and activities that:

- Shared with & supported by majority of active **working group** members.
- Fill **identified gap/s** & are **informed by evidence** when available/possible.
- Advance pace, quality, and/or scale of progress toward HEY!'s 10 year impact outcomes.\*
- Focus on intentionally including HEY!'s priority populations.\*
- Are **feasible**, with a clear, realistic implementation plan (SMART).
- Include a **plan for measuring impact** that aligns with the Shared Measurement framework.
- Meet legal requirements of 501c3 grant-making.
- **Share back learning** with the HEY! Network via network gatherings, reports, and/or Working Group gatherings.
- Are co-developed/-implemented with youth.
- Outline **sustainability** considerations and complementary funding opportunities.
- Are **collaborative** and implemented by multiple organizations.
- Are **synergistic** with other HEY! strategies and activities.

## What we don't fund:

- **Unsolicited** grant requests.
- Maintenance of existing programs or services.
- The **priorities of one** individual organization or program without significant changes to pace, quality, or scale.

## **Other Considerations:**

- Conflicts of interests need to be declared and excluded from voting or undue influence.
- Additional fundraising can be supported for larger, high potential proposals (dream big!)
- Not all proposals meeting the criteria are guaranteed to receive funding.
- Not all WG actions require funding.
- We recommend **\$1M in commitments in 2025** to ensure multi-year sustainability.
- HEY! should not inhibit or replace current funders' support in the behavioral health space. [HEY! is not the only vehicle].
